A consultation looks into your lifestyle and nutrition. The doctor can offer you personalised advice on how to make positive changes. If necessary, you are prescribed medication or referred on to a specialist.



Medical tests

Medical history

Complete a detailed questionnaire about your background and medical history.

Physical examination

The examination will help rule out any physical causes.

Total duration: 60 minutes

Blood test

A sample of your blood is taken so your hormones and glucose levels can be analysed.

Consultation

Talk through concerns, receive lifestyle advice and if necessary a prescription and/or referral.

Time with doctor: Up to 30 minutes, plus an optional 15 minutes follow-up to discuss results
