Bupa Oral Health Assessment

The oral health assessment involves a thorough evaluation of your gums, teeth and all visible oral tissues and structures. The purpose is to identify existing or potential problems, develop a treatment plan (if needed) and show you how to maintain excellent oral health.

Traditional care

Our dentists are trained to provide a full range of care. However, if a specific problem requires specialist treatment we will refer you to our London Centre of Excellence.

Great care is taken in selecting our dentists and specialists to ensure they have the clinical expertise and the empathetic qualities you'd expect.

We even have a dentist who specialises in caring for very anxious patients.

All of our practitioners work within industry recognised protocols, including clinical governance, and undergo regular internal clinical audits and assessments. Oral hygiene

Hygienist visits are an important part of your ongoing dental care. We recommend you visit the hygienist every six months. If more frequent visits are required, your dentist will discuss this with you further.

In order to keep your gums in good condition, part of your time will be spent with a dental hygienist. As well as scaling, cleaning your teeth and giving dietary advice, your hygienist will teach you how to look after your teeth and gums at home.

Cosmetic dentistry

We offer a full range of the latest cosmetic dentistry options including teeth whitening, tooth coloured restorations, veneers and implants.

Specialist treatment

Our London Centre of Excellence offers both specialist dental services and dentists.

Endodontists (for root treatment), oral surgeons, periodontist (for gum treatment), orthodontist (straightening teeth) and implant dentists are on-site to provide you with the care you need.
