"Our patients are children with long term ventilation, either invasive and non invasive therapy, children with life limiting conditions in palliative end of life phase and children with challenging behaviour.

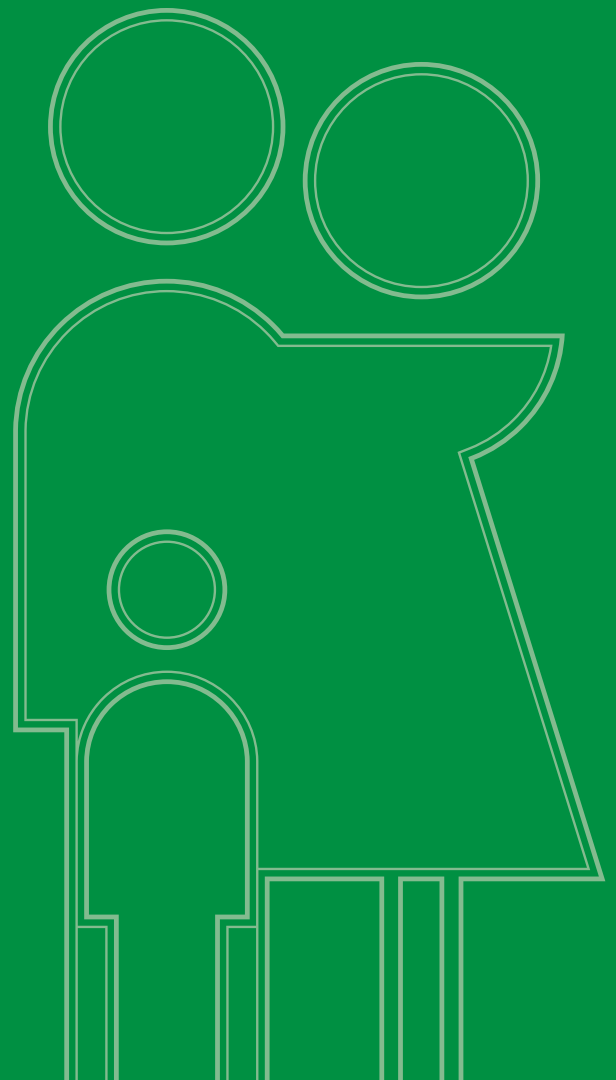
Bupa are saving a number of beds per annum and also reducing the number of admissions because of the level of their expertise.
