In the event of any positive results, we'll be there every step of the way with a follow-up GP appointment and 24/7 access to support through our Anytime HealthLine.

## What's included:

- ✓ Time with a Bupa health adviser to discuss the tests and outcomes
- ✓ A follow-up with a Bupa GP if any results are positive where they may provide treatment or onward referral
- ✓ One month's access to our 24/7 Anytime HealthLine after a positive test
- ✓ Assistance with partner notification can be provided if appropriate

## We'll test for:

- ✓ Chlamydia
- ✓ Gonorrhoea
- ✓ HIV
- ✓ Syphilis



## What happens at the appointment?



1. When you arrive at our centre, our team will welcome you and guide you to where to wait for your appointment.



2. One of our specially trained health advisers will then take you through to a private room where they will talk you through the tests, how you get your results and answer any questions you might have.



3. If any of your results are positive, you will be booked in for a consultation with one of our GPs where they can recommend treatment options or arrange for an onward referral.
