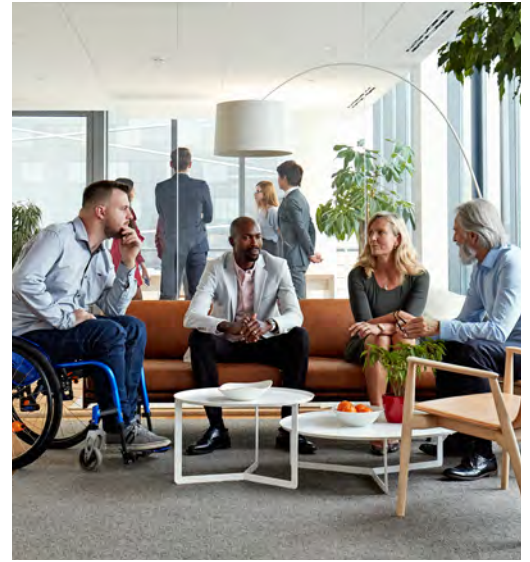
What's involved?

Career Ready is a UK-wide social mobility charity that works with employers to provide students aged 16-18 with a 12-month programme including workplace mentoring, a paid 4-week internship, and masterclasses on the skills needed for career success.

The high-impact programme transforms students' career skills, self-esteem, and understanding of the world of work, helping them to kickstart their future careers. And it's also a great way for businesses to connect with young talent and build inclusive workplaces.

We're asking businesses to get involved by providing a paid, 4-week internship to a young disabled person during July - August.

How we'll support you and the students

By partnering with Bupa on this initiative we'll provide additional support through our partners for you and the students:

Students will receive:

- A **4-week paid internship** hosted at your organisation
- A place on the **Career Ready 12-month programme** which includes a monthly mentoring session from a Bupa employee, workplace visits and 6 skills masterclasses
- **Access to Bupa's Healthy Minds Service**, 24/7 confidential telephone access to a team of specialists who can provide expert emotional and practical support
- **Access to Learn at Scope**, a new e-learning platform with employment based courses ranging from confidence and assertiveness to goal setting and time management
- Access to **disability workplace and culture training** provided by Scope
- **Meet members of the ParalympicsGB team** to hear their stories and visit their headquarters

Businesses will receive:

- **Guidance from Career Ready** on how to design and deliver an impactful internship, including student onboarding and how to structure the 4-week placement
- **Volunteer support from Career Ready**, including mentor and internship supervisor training, access to volunteer peer networks, and best practice handbooks and resources
- **Access to line manager training** from Scope: Employment barriers and lived experience
- **Access to Bupa's Academy** for Workplace health and wellbeing resources to support line managers
- **Access to Bupa's Internship insight working group** to share best practice
